Re: End of Summer Term

With the end of term approaching, I would like to confirm the arrangements for the end of this Summer Term for Year 12 students which I hope you find of use.

End of Term Finish Date

Year 12 students last day of the Summer Term will be Friday 21st July 2017 and they will not be required to attend lessons on Monday 24th July or Tuesday 25th July 2017. However, the Sixth Form Centre will be open on both these dates if they wish to complete independent study but unfortunately the café will not be open for food. If any students would like a one-to-one careers/UCAS meeting to discuss their Post 18 options, they can make an appointment to see me during this time.

Friday 14th July 2017 - Bright Day

Letters regarding the last Bright Day on Friday 14th July 2017 have been given to students. There is the opportunity for students to attend a day trip to London, visiting some of the many fantastic museums available to us. Students should return their money via Scopay (£20) and consent forms for this trip by Monday 10th July 2017.
