UCAS Higher Education Exhibition – Tuesday 25th April 2017

For many of the Year 12 students, they are beginning to consider their plans for after they leave the Sixth Form. Our 'Next Steps' programme is designed to support all students and will prepare them for Higher Education, further training, an apprenticeship or employment – whichever route they choose. During the recent Bright Days, students started to investigate possible Post 18 routes with the use of the UniFrog resource; looking at suitable work experience, Future Learn courses and appropriate university or apprenticeship routes. They also had the opportunity to attend the University of Nottingham Taster Day.

In order to support those who are considering applying to University, we have booked places at one of the annual UCAS Higher Education Exhibitions. At this event, which takes place at Loughborough University on Tuesday 25th April 2017, the vast majority of Universities run stalls from which students can collect prospectuses and gather other useful information. Crucially, they are able to speak to staff from a wide range of institutions all in one place and ask any questions that they may have. The event also includes a range of other organisations linked to Higher Education, such as Student Finance England.

We will leave school at 11.30am so students are able to attend Period 1 and Period 2 lessons as normal. We should arrive back in school by 3.00pm.

We will be asking for a contribution of £5.00 from those who wish to attend. This will go towards the cost of transport to and from the venue (we will pay the remaining cost); the event itself is free.
