**Re: Sport Relief 2018 — Whatever makes you move!**

This year we are really excited to be raising money for Sport Relief 2018. As one of the UK's biggest fundraising events, Sport Relief brings the entire nation together to get active, raise cash and change lives. The theme this year is 'Whatever makes you move'.

Arnold Hill Academy has decided to get involved and help raise money for this incredible cause. To do our bit and raise money, we have a number of activities happening and our key theme for 2018 is "To be more active than you are at the moment". The fun starts with coaching sessions led by Leicester Tigers for Year 7 & 8 rugby teams from across the three Trent Academies Group schools. These sessions will take place at Arnold Hill Academy on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March and will culminate in a competition that afternoon.

In the week leading up to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, pupils are encouraged to attend as many sports clubs as they can, and we would encourage you to sponsor your child or make a donation as a way to motivate them to raise money for Sport Relief. The timetable of activities is attached at the bottom of this letter to allow pupils to work out which extra clubs they would like to join.

On top of this there will also be a 'Staff vs 6<sup>th</sup> Form' basketball game on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> March where pupils can come along and support those involved. These are usually closely contested games and the staff will be hoping to get revenge after being beaten last time around!
