



Uniform Queries – Frequently Asked Questions

Why does Arnold Hill Academy have one uniform supplier? – Uniform means the same. All students are expected to wear their uniform correctly and consistently. By having one supplier they can ensure you have the correct items.

Is Arnold Hill Academy uniform more expensive than other secondary schools? No. It is cheaper than or in line with many schools in the local area – we as a school took the decision not to put logos on uniform which does make it more expensive.

Which items must be only purchased from Schoolwear Solutions? Blazer, trousers, skirts, ties, green PE polo shirt (all students), green PE socks (girls) and PE rugby shirt (boys).

What will happen if I send my child to school wearing incorrect uniform?

If there are any issues with uniform students will not be allowed into lessons. We ask for a written note from parents if there is an issue with your child's uniform – your child should come to PSU first thing with this.

What if they don't have my child's size? Schoolwear Solutions will ensure that they have this, even if it means ordering it.
